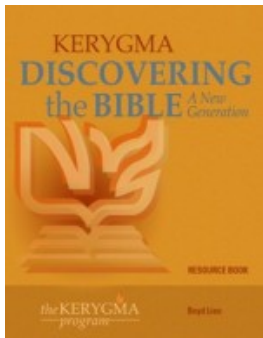


“Discovering the Bible: A New Generation” Offered Fall 2011

We will be offering this course led by Pastor Steve beginning September 21st. This is an updated version of the course we have offered before and the book and format is entirely different. It will be a new experience for everyone. We are offering this course at noon on Wednesdays so that those who want to take their lunch hour to attend may and so that those who do not drive at night may also attend. Individuals from the congregation and the community are welcome. You will need to sign up ahead of time so we can order enough books. They are \$30 apiece. Since the course is 30 sessions and we will break for holidays, it will span the majority of the school year.

Introducing you to the people, places and stories of the Bible. This invitation to find where *The Story* lives in *your story* provides the perfect meeting place for both those brand-new to Bible study, and those who have had long familiarity with Scripture.



Incorporating good scholarship with sound learning principles, *Discovering the Bible: A New Generation* is ideal for weekday groups excited to pursue a study of the Bible whole. Through a process of reading, reflections, discussion, creative expression and discovery, both the first-time learner and the lifelong student are invited to a deeper knowledge and understanding of the Bible. The course will be scheduled for one hour meetings, and will be led by Pastor Steve.

The 30 sessions will also be divided into modular study units allowing room for appropriate seasonal breaks. Whether used as a preparatory course to *Kerygma: the Bible in Depth* or as an independent study, *Discovering the Bible: A New Generation* provides adults with an engaging and rewarding encounter with Scripture they will always be glad they experienced. The Bible in Depth will most likely be offered the following year.
